Despite bringing a period of democracy and freedom to Portugal, the 25th of April also resulted in a turbulent decolonization process as well as a troubled and contested legacy for Lusophone nations, populations and immigrant communities. This symposium will investigate the last 50 years of this legacy, from an interdisciplinary and intersectoral academic perspective.
